

April Vestry Meeting Summary

The Vestry celebrated a joyful Holy Week and Easter season, noting strong attendance at worship services, including bilingual liturgies, and expressing gratitude to the many volunteers who made the annual Easter Brunch possible. The parish also expanded efforts to care for homebound members through regular visits, Holy Communion, and flower deliveries.

Property updates focused on several significant campus improvement projects, including the parlor renovation, plumbing repairs, courtyard infrastructure, new signage, parking lot improvements, and other facility needs. The Vestry also explored potential grant funding opportunities to help support these projects.

The Finance Committee received approval to establish long-term investment accounts with the Episcopal Diocese of Texas Participating Fund and appointed an Audit Review Committee to conduct the annual financial review. Additionally, the Governance Committee outlined its 2026 work plan, which includes updating parish bylaws, emergency preparedness plans, and governance documents for Saint Andrew's ministries.
